

1871 Census Extracts - Rosewarne

The following list of Rosewarnes has been extracted from the 1871 UK census. Most of the names have been extracted from the Kindred Konnections online transcript, but four households are included which are missing from the Kindred Konnections list (kindly contributed by Vic Rosewarne).

I can't guarantee that the transcription is free from errors or omissions. If you notice any please let me know and I will be happy to correct them. As with any transcript, you should **always** check the original records if you think an entry may relate to your family. Not only will this verify that the details are correct, but the original record may well contain additional information.

The census was taken on the night of 2 April 1871. The names are arranged by household and parish. The Status column indicates whether married (M), unmarried (U) or widowed (W). The Other Details column contains additional information including relationship to head of household, or other details included in the census return.
